Interfaith's Turk Center, a former 77-room motel in Escondido, provides 106 Recuperative Care beds for unsheltered people discharged from the hospital. The program provides a stable and clean environment. While staying at Turk, clients work with Interfaith case managers to ensure they are following up with their primary care providers, stabilizing their medical or mental health conditions, while supporting them to obtain benefits and long term permanent housing. With the ultimate goal of moving them towards self-sufficiency.

→ Program Goals

- Stabilize the member's medical or mental health condition
- Engage them in managing their ongoing physical and mental health care
- Addressing short term and long term needs of unhoused individuals
- Connecting their medical, psychiatric, and substance use disorder recovery to longer term care as needed.

→ Comprehensive care model

- Receive individualized case management and care coordination for medical and social determinance of health.
- Receive comprehensive clinical services
- Receive support with medication management
- 24- hour on site staffing
- Coordination with home health and hospice services as needed.
